1. APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION AS AN ACCREDITED CHECKER

Subject to Section 10B of the Registration of Engineers 1967 (Revised 2007), the following person may apply to be considered by the Board for registration as an Accredited Checker:

- (i) he is a Professional Engineer registered under the Act in the Civil, Structural or Geotechnical branch of engineering;
- (ii) he has at least 10 years relevant practical experience in the design and construction of buildings as defined in the Street, Drainage and Building Act 1974 [Act 133];
- (iii) has adequate experience in one of the following;
 - a) **Geotechnical**
 - i. Foundations;
 - ii. Retaining Systems and Reinforced Soil Structures; and
 - iii. Slope Engineering and Embankments;
 - b) **Structural**
 - i. Buildings exceeding 5 storeys;
 - ii. Buildings of unconventional constructions with spans exceeding 10 metres; and
 - iii. Buildings that will result in complex interactions with existing buildings;
- (iv) has practical experience in the relevant field gained in Malaysia for a continuous period of 1 year immediately preceding the date of his application.
